A high-quality early childcare program can be the difference between success and falling into the achievement gap:

- 90% of a child's brain develops between birth and five years of age.
- Education begins at birth: an infant is born with approximately 100 billion brain cells. If an infant is immersed in an environment that is *stimulating*, *nurturing*, and *responsive* to the baby's needs, the child's brain will more closely resemble an adult's than a newborn's by the age of three! TLC's nursery for infants eight weeks and older sets the tone for a dynamic early childhood education that will continue until a child graduates from our preschool program at six years old.

A child's future success and their earliest years are deeply intertwined:

- High quality preschool programs boost language and literacy skills.
- School achievement in the 6th grade directly correlates to a child's development between 12 and 42 months of age and an enriched environment like TLC's ensures 25% more brain connections!
- Research shows us that learning to read is a lengthy process that begins *before* children enter formal schooling. Children who start early at TLC are more likely to enter grade school with a head start on reading and writing that will set the pace for their skill-acquisition throughout their schooling.

TLC is one of the highest quality childcare centers in Boulder County:

- A combined early childhood education center and pediatric therapy clinic.
- Accredited by Colorado Shines as a Level Four Colorado Shines childcare facility (out of five levels).
- Highly qualified teachers and staff (degrees in early childhood education).
- Low adult-to-child ratio of 10:1 (more nurturing adults to meet the needs of each child).
- Fully inclusive classrooms serve children both with and without special needs.
